INTRODUCTION:

1. "Te Roopu Tai Ao Ki Waitangi", having mana Whenua, mana Moana status in terms of the authority of the un extinguished Native Aboriginal Right to the un extinguished Native Title.

TE ROOPU TAI AO KI WAITANGI:

2. Is appointed by the Te Tii Waitangi Marae Mauri Komiti, Te Tii Waitangi Marae, Waitangi to monitor all activities that pertain to the Whenua and Moana within our Ancestral territories.

TE TII WAITANGI MARAE, TE TII WAITANGI

3. Te Tii Waitangi Marae is Kaitiaki to the Legislated authority of New Zealand, namely the International protectorates:

He Wakaputanga O te Rangatiratanga O Nu Tireni 1835

Te Tiriti O Waitangi 1840.

Te Tii Waitangi Marae is Kaitiaki to Te Wakaminenga O Nga Hapu O Nu Tireni.

TE WAKAMINENGA O NGA HAPU O NU TIRENI
