- ① Looking for space to be reserved for Maori tourists in desert. Not free, will pay.
- ② Wairangi - Check with the engineers what oil traps are in place.
- ③ Pahiia:
  - Not want liquor licence on the wharf area. opposed Aqueduct. Building for other reasons.
  - \$2k per year for ecol
  - Hahumare - very important issue
    - move bones from island to hills
    - now wanting them back.
  - Puhai - great great grand father chief on island.
  - <sup>Hotu</sup> Taylor Island - Kuia Rongorua. etc
  - Concern on erosion of Hahumare Island if beach waters are created.
  - Fresh water springs under the bay.
  - No beach waters not to be used as access to island.
  - Maori Maori's use channel to travel down the coast. Must be opening between Bluff's Hotu Island.
  - Kaimoana off of the Bluff area.
  - No Kiyaks on the islands.
  - Storm water - How will this come thro. the beach.
  - Ensure that a lagoon/bay has a adequate current & sea circulation
  - Ensure not wave reflection does not damage Tevi beach.

- Beach - concerns that it will result in damage to other beaches. Not sure how?
- Kidanga - Moon Cultural Value.
- Want to know what impact is on the adjacent beaches.
- Dripper with original reef line is used.
- Bob Kinrik - Reclaimed Wairangi Beach.
- Program to restore shell fish on the islands.
  - Kuti
  - Manuduna - Central breeding ground.
- What will the old movement be?
- Issue is the loss of shell fish due to build up of sand.
- Moon access the beach for shell fish collecting but don't go onto the island.
- Are there Harbour Board records of rocks being dynamited out of the reefs. - About 1940's
- Drop mats for diesel on wharf.
- Add other islands to the picture.
- Return to natural equilibrium.
